

THE EVOLUTION OF THE STRATEGIC DISCOURSE OF THE JUSTICE AND DEVELOPMENT PARTY IN TURKEY

Abstract: The article analyzes the evolution of the discourse of the ruling Justice and Development Party (AKP) in Turkey since 2002, thereby filling a gap in the academic literature in Bulgarian. The text traces the strategic discourses in Turkey until 2002, when AKP came to power. Its second part delves into the evolution of the AKP discourse, examining the issue in the context of internal and external political processes that cause the corresponding changes in the rhetoric used.
